ANTITRUST COMPLIANCE POLICY

It is the intent of the North Texas Measurement Association (NTMA) executive board and membership to comply with all applicable U.S. federal and state antitrust laws, as well as similar foreign competition laws. NTMA will not knowingly, directly or indirectly, participate in any conduct that leads to or implies an agreement among its members that would restrain trade and/or otherwise violate applicable antitrust laws.

Guidelines for NTMA Meetings and Functions

NTMA conducts meetings and educational events in a manner that avoids even the appearance of improper conduct. All NTMA meetings, functions, conference calls, or other activities follow set procedures and guidelines. Meetings follow a written agenda and are led by a chairperson. Minutes include documentation of location, date and time, attendance, discussion, and voting. Discussions regarding pricing, discounts, customer market activity, company inside information, and purchasing or sales strategies are never allowed.

Meetings and Educational Events

NTMA shall provide the topics and synopses for presentations to speakers before meetings and at its educational events, and clearly communicate these guidelines and requirements. Speakers should be informed of this Policy well in advance of meetings or educational event dates so speakers can have adequate time to review the Policy in developing their presentations.

Compliance

NTMA members will be provided a copy of this Policy. Compliance with this Policy is a membership requirement. Members can be removed from NTMA for violating this Policy. NTMA Board of Directors will communicate with members when questions are raised concerning their compliance with this Policy.
